cox graae + spack architects designed a phased renovation for Blessed Sacrament School and Church to expand the academic space on campus for use by the school. Located in Chevy Chase Circle, the school was encompassed in a 1920's era Gothic stone Church, Convent, and Parish House, however renovations and additions were designed to re-purpose the Parish House into a new Parish Center and convert the historic Convent into academic space while linking it to the original school with a new infill structure. The school complex now features a new entrance lobby, media center, science and computer labs, music and art studios, and a kindergarten center.
